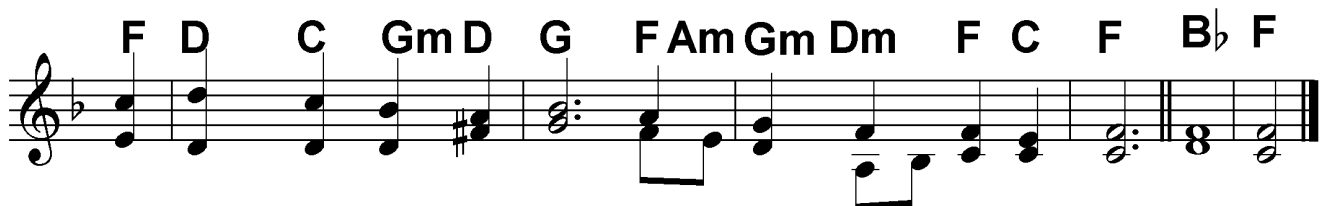
1. Now thank we all our God With heart and hands and voic - es,
