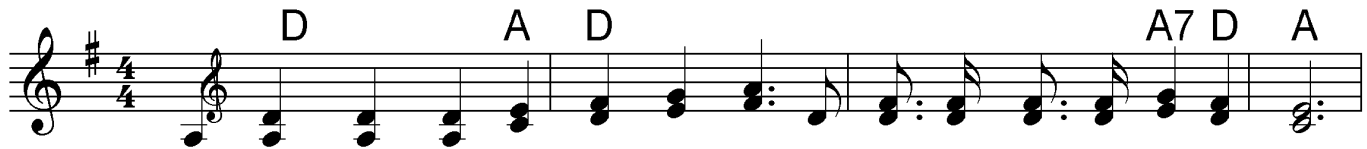


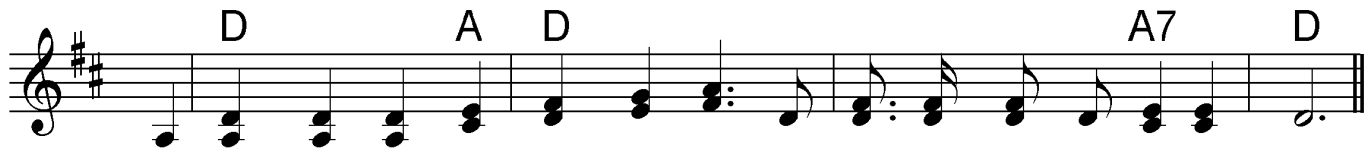
A Shelter in the Time of Storm
